How to start

- Click on the link above and select English or French
- Select one of our products from the menu bar at the top to begin an illustration
- Enter the specifics for your client(s), completing the mandatory fields noted by the red *
- Below the menu bar, the sections of the illustration are broken into submenus for Client,
 Owner, Coverage, Riders and Benefits to allow input of the specifics needed to tailor the illustration to your client's needs
 - Note: Universal Life also has Solves/Premiums, Funding and Withdrawals
- The right-hand summary panel provides a running peek at the details entered and the premium for the product selected
- Universal Life Illustrations, click the refresh button/link to update the summary panel

Running a new case and other options

Above the summary panel on the right side, there are options to:

	Start a new case
	Refresh the calculations/solves
X	Export UL and Whole Life to excel
	Adjust the pages in the report and the years shown with the report selector option
	Generate the illustration report (refer to Running Reports below for additional details)

After completing all of the required input on the left, Select the illustration report icon.

You will be asked to complete the Advisor Information page with your information. This data is displayed on the illustration report and is saved only for the duration of the session in order to be available for every case! Once you contracted it becomes permanent.

After the illustration report has been generated, it lands on an Adobe Acrobat landing page.

From this page you have a number of options:

You can scroll through the pages of the report, print, download and access a pdf.



This icon on the top left will bring up thumb nails of individual pages



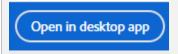
Top left you will find the print icon

Another option, is the desktop version of Adobe

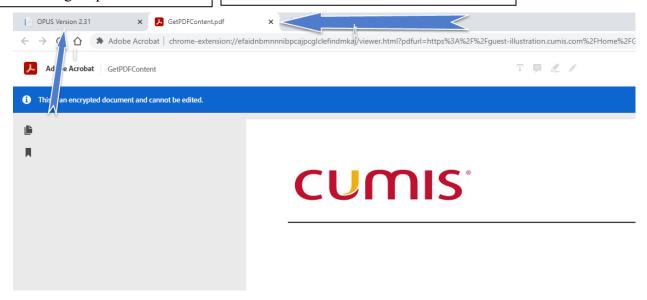


Top right of the Desktop version allows you to e-mail the pdf

GetPDFContent.net gives you access to the Adobe landing page where your report can be accessed for printing etc.



Other Features:

Participating Whole Life and Universal Life illustrations can now be exported into a spreadsheet.

The spreadsheet can then be imported directly into services such as LDA, without the need to cut and paste.
